Non compliance to foreign acts, rules and regulations is considered by the CSRC to be in violation of Securities Law under By-Law 17, Notice 23”.

The settlement amount will be set at \$19,675,871.76USD Bank of China has been assigned the distribution and contact of the LXX Inc. shareholders, their accounts division is well versed in this process, as to impede any improprieties in these transactions a third party bank account has been established, BOC LTD Holdings/JP Morgan Chase N.A, USA will be used as the escrow for funds and for any fees generated and be monitored/controlled by the CSRC.

In conclusion all shareholders will be contacted to participate in the settlement; the amount of the settlement is determined by your purchased share amount and response to the inquiry, so it’s imperative that you respond to the contact by Bank of China and its representatives and associates.
