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


Who We Are

We Are Different

Shuma works alongside her husband Ansar Noor who owns Coastal Estates. In March 2020 Ansar began working with Southend-on-Sea Borough Council and became a part of the coordinated approach to provide emergency housing for rough sleepers, who have mental health conditions and drug and alcohol dependency.

The aim of this project is to keep people safe whilst the Country tackles coronavirus. The Branch Hotel now houses over 20 rough sleepers and Shuma and her husband Ansar work closely alongside St Vincent De Paul Society to feed rough sleepers on a weekly basis.

Shuma recognised the impact that coronavirus had on vulnerable people and wanted to create a safe space for people with disabilities who are affected by coronavirus and struggle to maintain their own tenancies and live as independently as possible.

Coastal Supported Living provides a unique combination of transformative care, support and housing solutions for adults, this high quality supportive service and housing eliminates barriers that result in extended stays in institutional settings.
